



Performance & Display Policy

- a) Performances / Displays shall not exploit the bodies of men, women, boys or girls solely for the purpose of attracting attention.
- b) Performances / Displays shall not stereotype according to race, ancestry, place of origin, ethnic origin, citizenship, colour, creed, sex, age, sexual orientation, disability, family or marital status, or any ground covered by the City of Toronto Workplace Human Rights Policy.
- c) Performances / Displays shall not promote the hatred or derision of any group covered by the City of Toronto Workplace Human Rights Policy.
- d) Performances / Displays shall be consistent with the principle of respect for the dignity and worth of all people.
- e) Performances / Displays must not advocate a specific political or religious point of view for the purpose of proselytizing. Any religious or political reference should be in the context of a larger cultural event.
- f) As the Square is open to use by the general public at all times, performances / displays on the Square must be consistent with the use of the Square by others including children.
